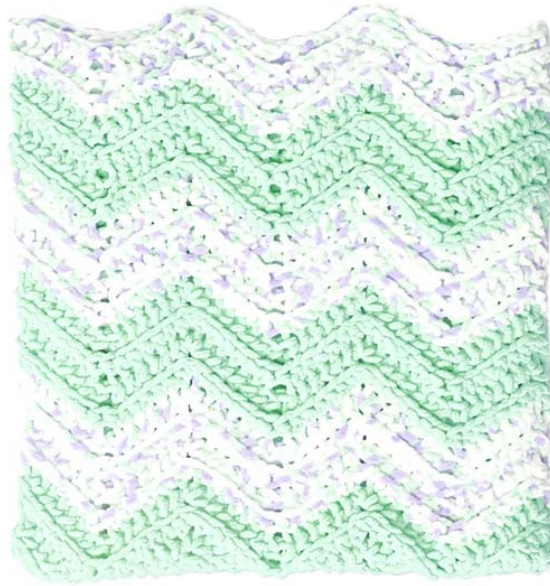

Free Crochet Pattern

Chevron Baby Blanket

Beginner Friendly | Back Loop Only | Stripe Texture

A classic chevron blanket in a soft two-tone lilac stripe. Worked in single crochet through back loops only for a beautiful ridged texture. Finished size: approximately 38 x 42 inches (96.5 x 106.5 cm).

Materials

Yarn	Bulky weight (size 6) baby yarn: Colour A: Soft Lilac Print — 246 yds (225 m) Colour B: Baby Lilac (solid) — 194 yds (177 m)
Hook	8mm (US L/11)
Gauge	7 sc x 8 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in single crochet
Other	Yarn needle, scissors

Abbreviations

ch = chain
RS = right side

sc = single crochet
rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
blo = back loop only

Notes

- All stitches are worked into the back loop only throughout the entire blanket.
- Stripe Pattern: Work 4 rows with Colour A, then 4 rows with Colour B. Repeat these 8 rows throughout.
- When changing colours, carry the unused yarn up the side edge rather than cutting it each time.
- Chevron peaks = 3 sc in one stitch. Chevron valleys = skip 2 stitches.

Pattern Instructions

Foundation chain: With Colour A, chain 86.

Row 1 (RS): 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *1 sc in each of next 6 ch, skip 1 ch, 1 sc in each of next 6 ch, 3 sc in next ch. Rep from * across, ending last rep with 2 sc in last ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1. Working into back loops only of each st: 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc, skip next 2 sc, 1 sc in each of next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc. Rep from * across, ending last rep with 2 sc in last sc. Turn.

Continue: Rep Row 2, following the Stripe Pattern (4 rows Colour A, 4 rows Colour B), until blanket measures approximately 42 inches (106.5 cm) from beginning, ending with 4 rows of Colour A.

Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Stripe Sequence

Rows	Colour
1-4	Colour A (Lilac Print)
5-8	Colour B (Solid Lilac)
9-12	Colour A
13-16	Colour B
Continue repeating...	

Tips for Success

- Count stitches at the end of each row — the stitch count should stay the same throughout.
- If the blanket feels stiff, go up half a hook size to loosen your tension.
- A light steam block when finished will even out the chevron points beautifully.

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
