Free Crochet Pattern

Ribbon Baby Booties

Beginner Friendly | Newborn to 6 Months | No Rounds Needed

Simple flat-construction crochet baby booties with a pretty ribbon bow. Worked entirely in rows — no working in the round — making these perfect for absolute beginners. Sized newborn to 6 months.

Materials

Yarn	DK weight cotton or cotton-acrylic blend, approx 50g (cream or white shown)
Hook	3.5mm (US E/4)
Gauge	20 sc x 24 rows = 4 inches (10 cm)
Other	18 inches (46 cm) satin ribbon (1/4 inch wide), yarn needle, scissors

Abbreviations

ch = chain	sc = single crochet	sl st = slip stitch
inc = 2sc in 1 st	dec = sc2tog	RS = right side

Pattern Instructions (Newborn) — Make 2

Foundation: Ch 14.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Turn. (13 sc)

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn. (sole)

Row 7 (toe): Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in last 4 sts. Turn. (15 sc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in last 5 sts. Turn. (17 sc)

Rows 10-12: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn.

Row 13 (ankle): Ch 1, sc in first 6 sts, ch 3, skip 5 sts, sc in last 6 sts. Turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch across. Turn. (15 sc)

Rows 15-16: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn.

Fasten off. Fold bootie in half RS together, seam the back and foot edges. Thread ribbon through ch-3 eyelet and tie in a bow. Weave in ends.

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
