



Bloom Bonnet
Free Crochet Pattern

Rosebud Baby Bonnet

Beginner Friendly | Newborn to 3 Months | Scallop Edge

A delicate crochet baby bonnet with a pretty scallop edge and ribbon ties. Worked flat in rows from the back of the head forward, then finished with a scallop edging around the face opening. Beginner-friendly in DK yarn.

Materials

Yarn	DK weight yarn (cotton or cotton-acrylic blend), approx 75g in blush pink or white
Hook	4mm (US G/6)
Gauge	18 sc x 22 rows = 4 inches (10 cm)
Other	24 inches (60 cm) satin ribbon (3/8 inch wide), yarn needle, scissors

Abbreviations

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet
sk = skip

dc = double crochet
rep = repeat

Pattern Instructions

Foundation: Ch 37.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Turn. (36 sc)

Rows 2-20: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn. (back panel)

Row 21 (shaping): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog. Turn. (34 sc)

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn.

Rows 23-28: Rep Rows 21-22 three more times. (28 sc after Row 27)

Rows 29-34: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn. (sides of bonnet)

Tie (make 2): Join yarn at corner of face opening edge. Ch 30. Fasten off.

Scallop edging: Join yarn at right corner of face opening. *Sk 1 st, 5dc in next st, sk 1 st, sl st in next st. Rep from * around face opening edge. Fasten off.

Finishing: Thread ribbon through ties or attach ribbon at corners. Weave in all ends.
